

Call for 2018 WCSA Jake Ryan Award Submissions

The Working-Class Studies Association (WCSA) invites nominations (including self-nominations) for the **Jake Ryan Award** for a book published in 2018

Established in 2017, the award honors Jake Ryan, co-editor of the first known working-class academics anthology, *Strangers in Paradise: Academics from the Working Class* (1984). The award recognizes work that speaks to issues of importance to the working-class academic experience.

Please consider nominating an entry, and please circulate this announcement.

To be eligible, works must have been published between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018.

To nominate a work for consideration, please send three hard copies with a cover letter indicating why it deserves recognition.

Nominations are due no later than **March 19, 2019**.
